Collection and Processing Procedure:

- **Transport Organization:**
 - Direct transport is organized from Uccle to Dottignies, ensuring an efficient and secure transfer of bulletproof vests.
 - The federal police provide an escort to Dottignies, guaranteeing safety during transport.
- **Storage Upon Arrival:**
 - The cages containing the vests are stored in a locked 40ft container within our secure warehouse in Dottignies, minimizing the risk of damage or theft.
 - Our production facility features security doors that are locked outside of production hours, enhanced by an external video surveillance system and an advanced intrusion alarm system within the facility, all directly connected to a control center for immediate response in the event of any incidents.
- **Documentation and Verification:**
 - Each cage comes with a detailed list, including serial numbers, the quantity of items, and the gross and net weight, ensuring accuracy and ease of processing.
 - All cages are weighed and checked upon arrival to immediately identify and address any discrepancies.
- **Processing Procedure:**
 - The vests are processed as quickly as possible following their delivery, going through an industrial guillotine and cut in half to ensure their immediate destruction, the bulletproof vests are then ready for dismantling.
 - The outer textile is separated, shredded, and sent for incineration. Para-aramid fabrics are transformed into fibers for recycling, while ceramic plates are broken and properly disposed of.
